ATLANTA -- Atlanta police say robbery may have been the motive behind a shooting in southwest Atlanta that left a cab driver dead and a family torn. Stephen Anim, 57, of Austell is one of the founders of Star Cab Company. Anim was shot and killed at about 1:20 a.m. Wednesday near the intersection of Richard Allen Boulevard and Fairburn Road in southwest Atlanta. Medshare Volunteering Update

Twelve G-WAG ladies marked the start of our community service campaign by volunteering at Medshare International in Decatur Georgia last Saturday, to sort, label and pack surplus medical supplies. The event was organized by the members of the Planning & Programming Committee.

Most of the supplies that the G-WAG ladies helped to pack were donations from hospitals and medical facilities in the metro-Atlanta area and ranged from IV set-up kits to surgery gowns. While many people around the world suffer from lack of healthcare, U.S. hospitals discard hundreds of millions of dollars worth of medical supplies they can no longer use.

In line with its primary objective of increasing access to healthcare for women and children, the G-WAG seeks to establish a strategic alliance with Medshare International and ship medical supplies to hospitals in Ghana – especially for obstetric and pediatric care.
