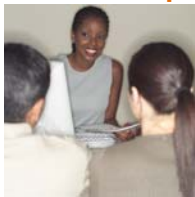

RESOURCES

Under the **Unclaimed Property Act**, when someone holds property (holder) that belongs to someone else (owner), but has lost contact with the owner for a specified period (holding period), that holder must turn over (remit) the property to the State. The State serves as the custodian for any property remitted under the Act allowing the owners or their heirs an opportunity to claim their property in the future.

Property can range from gift certificates or credit memos, unpaid wages, employee benefit trust distributions and income, safe deposit boxes, bequeathed property, and intangible personal property (stocks, bonds, etc.) held or owing in this State.
